Students and Parents,

NTS Camp is scheduled for July 9-13, 2023 back at Houghton College, NY!

God has used this camp to call students into saving relationships with Himself as well as establish meaningful friendships among peers. God has helped students overcome hurts, and to gain a much better understanding of who He is. The fruit we have seen out of this camp has been incredible, that is why we are eager to go again. We are inviting students who will be completing grades 6 through 12 to join us this summer. Students must regularly attend Crosswinds Church during the 2022-23 school year to be eligible for camp!

The main purpose of this letter is to get families informed and to provide ways for students to fundraise their way to camp!

Pricing:

Registration for camp is \$385.00 <u>until</u> **May 7**. Later Registration is from May 8 to June 25 and is \$405.00. Last minute registration is from June 26 to July 8 and is \$430.00. Final payment is due two weeks before camp, June 26, or there will be a \$20 late fee added. We encourage you to lock in the cheapest option and register before May 7, only needing to pay the initial deposit of \$150.00 at time of registration.

Registration:

To register for camp, please go to ntscamp.com. Click on the "REGISTER FOR CAMP" button and select the New York location. Then click on "Crosswinds Wesleyan Church." **Note**: You must be the parent or legal guardian 18 years or older to complete the registration process.

You will be asked to enter student/parent information and read and "sign" the NTS Camp waiver. To complete your registration process you will need to either pay the \$150 nonrefundable/nontransferable deposit or pay the entire amount. You will need to use a credit card or debit card for this. (*Keep reading to see fundraising/scholarship opportunities!*)

Once you register, you will be sent a confirmation email stating that you have registered and paid/owe for NTS Camp. This email will include a packing list and any forms that may be required for camp.

Fundraising/Scholarships:

This year, to help students get to camp, Crosswinds is offering three opportunities/recommendations that are available to all students who register for NTS Camp.

- 1. NTS Camp Memorization Program (ends June 7). This is an opportunity for students to earn a \$100.00 scholarship towards their trip by memorizing scripture and being an active participant in our worship services. Following this page you will see more information about it.
- Coffee and NTS Cookies Fundraiser (Sunday, May 7). We are going to hold a coffee
 and cookie fundraiser at Crosswinds! Students who participate in the cookie fundraiser
 will be eligible to receive a portion of the funds towards their camp registration.
- 3. **Support Letters.** We consider NTS Camp an investment to your spiritual journey. Others do as well. We encourage you to write letters to families and friends explaining what you'll be up to, and how they can partner alongside you in prayer and possibly supporting you financially.

When money is raised, or when money is earned through a scholarship, Crosswinds will be able to enter those funds directly into your NTS Camp account (you have to be registered first). You will be notified when money is added towards your account when it happens.

Pray!

We want to ask you to begin to pray about this trip. Pray if this camp is something that you, your student, or perhaps even a friend should be at. Pray that God would give you clarity if you should go or not. Pray that financial means would be met. Pray that God is already preparing your hearts and those of others. Pray that God is guiding and leading the NTS staff as they prepare.

NTS Camp Scholarship Program

Program Ends on June 7, 2023

Details:

This is an opportunity for students going to NTS Camp 2023 to earn a scholarship through Crosswinds Wesleyan Church. There are two tasks that each student group will have to fulfill if they want to receive a scholarship. Scholarships will be of \$100.00 value, and will be applied directly to the student's NTS Camp fee.

For students to earn the scholarship they will need to complete the required Bible Verse Memorization and Sermon Notes. Details are provided below.

FAQ:

Who can participate in the NTS Camp Memorization Program?

All students going to NTS Camp can complete the program.

How do I complete it?

The program will end on June 7. If you submitted the required Sermon Notes for your grade level, and you have been successfully tested on your memorization of scripture by a Student Ministry Leader you will be awarded the scholarship.

How do I get tested for memory of scripture?

As you memorize scriptures, mark on the sheets which verses you are choosing to memorize. Give this to a Student Ministry Leader who will be testing your memory. Here are the ways in which you can be tested:

- At a Student Ministry evening, you can ask your Student Ministry Leader to test you by giving them the sheet with the scriptures you memorized.
- You can set up a time with Wendy, Seanna or your Student Ministry Leader outside of Wednesday nights to be tested (you can find them on a weekend and ask them then. If they are unable to do it on the spot, then they will set up a time).
- You do not need to be tested on all verses at one time.
- If you have memorized and been tested on our weekly memory verses, those will count towards your required number.

Middle School (6-8 grade):

- Memorize word for word, 30 of the verses listed on the following page. Your weekly
 memory verses that are tracked in your leader's binder count towards your scholarship
 requirements.
- Take notes on a total of three (3) weekend teachings or Wednesday night Student Ministry teachings from Crosswinds Wesleyan Church. Your Sermon Notes must be written on the provided Sermon Notes sheets and turned in the following Sunday. The Sermon Notes sheets can be found at Crosswinds Central as well as near The Box. Sermon Notes can be placed in the Student Ministry Drop Box located outside The Box.

High School (9-12 grade):

- Memorize word for word, 40 of the verses listed on the following page. Your weekly memory verses that are tracked in your leader's binder count towards your scholarship requirements.
- Take notes on a total of five (5) weekend teachings or Wednesday night Student
 Ministry teachings from Crosswinds Wesleyan Church. Your Sermon Notes must
 be written on the provided Sermon Notes sheets and turned in the following Sunday.
 The Sermon Notes sheets can be found at Crosswinds Central as well as near The
 Box. Sermon Notes can be placed in the Student Ministry Drop Box located outside
 The Box.

**NOTE! If you are not following the weekly memory verses, please choose verses from the attached sheet to memorize. If you have memorized some of the weekly verses, please choose the remainder of your verses from the attached sheets. See your Connect Group Leader to find out how many verses you have already memorized.
